

HOW TO SET UP ZUBRI PATIO HEATER


Notice: These heaters are designed to be used for outdoor use only.



Snap legs in place. Attach base stabilizer for added stability.



Attach unit through the reflector center hole. Flip the folding wing nut and screw down onto reflector until secure



Hang propane tank using bracket provided. Attach hose to propane tank, tighten securely.



Wrap skirt around heater legs to cover propane tank. Zip up and secure with Velcro closure.



Turn the propane tank's supply valve open. Hold a lit butane lighter next to burner head.



Push and turn control knob to middle position. After heater lights, keep the control knob pushed for at least 15 secs. Release slowly and adjust heat.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	QUICK FIX
Not heating or low temperature	Check to make sure propane tank is full.
	Ensure that the propane tank is properly attached to the hose.
	 Turn burner knob to OPEN and wait for a few seconds. Repeat a few times if it will not ignite.



ITEMS INCLUDED



PROPANE USE & SAFETY

CONNECTING TANK

- Remove the main tank's valve plug. Thread the POL connector snugly into the main tank by turning the tank valve counter-clockwise.
- Always position the propane tank so that the connecting hose is not bent.

GENERAL USE & DISCONNECTING

- Use soapy water to test all fittings and connections for leaks before operating the appliance.
- NEVER use propane tanks indoors.
- Propane tanks are designed to be used with the valve completely open. Never leave the
 valve partially open or closed.
- When not in use, turn off all temperature controls and completely close the main valve on the propane tank.

STORAGE & TRANSPORTING

- All propane tanks must be secured in an upright position.
- To prevent the propane tank from being overturned, place in a box or crate.
- Never store propane tanks in a building or a hot vehicle. Heat may cause the relief valve to discharge propane and create a dangerous situation.

BEFORE RETURNING

- Propane tank must be disconnected from unit.
- All items must be placed back into carrying case.
