

## CONTROL FUNCTIONS



## HOW TO OPERATE

- Move oven to its final location. Ensure there is a minimum 3 inches clearance from each side of the oven for proper air flow.
- Connect the gas supply (eg. propane tank) to the oven.
- Plug in the electrical cord to a grounded outlet.
- Turn power ON. Set temperature on oven by turning dial to desired temperature.
- Turn Timer dial to set cooking time.
- Once usage of oven is complete, turn dials to zero. Turn OFF power and cool down unit. Unplug from outlet and disconnect from propane tank.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	QUICK FIX
<i>No heat</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure that the unit is plugged in and the power switch is in the ON position.</li> <li>Gas valve to oven may be in the closed position. Open gas valve. Ensure that there is proper gas connection.</li> <li>Ensure that the door is closed.</li> </ul>
<i>Fan does not work</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Check electrical supply.</li> <li>Ensure that the door is closed.</li> </ul>

## ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS



### DANGER

- Machine must be properly grounded to prevent electrical shock to personnel. Failure to do so could result in serious injury, or death.
- Keep cord and plug off the ground and away from moisture. Do not use extension cord.
- Always unplug the equipment before cleaning or servicing.
- Make sure all machine switches are in the OFF position before plugging the equipment into the receptacle.

## PROPANE USE & SAFETY

### CONNECTING TANK

- Remove the main tank's valve plug. Thread the POL connector snugly into the main tank by turning the tank valve counter-clockwise.
- Always position the propane tank so that the connecting hose is not bent.

### GENERAL USE & DISCONNECTING

- Use soapy water to test all fittings and connections for leaks before operating the appliance.
- NEVER use propane tanks indoors.
- Propane tanks are designed to be used with the valve completely open. Never leave the valve partially open or closed.
- When not in use, turn off all temperature controls. Completely close the main valve on tank.

### STORAGE & TRANSPORTING

- All propane tanks must be secured in an upright position.
- To prevent the propane tank from being overturned, place in a box or crate.
- Never store propane tanks in a building or a hot vehicle. Heat may cause the relief valve to discharge propane and create a dangerous situation.

## BEFORE RETURNING

- A \$67.50 cleaning charge will apply to each convection oven if units are not returned in the same condition they were received.
- To avoid cleaning charges, remove food residue. Wipe down all interior and exterior surface areas clean.
