





WARNING

- To avoid burns, do not touch the kettle or any heated surface.
- Do not place or leave objects in contact with heated surfaces.



♠ CAUTION

- Do not allow the general public to handle machine when used in food service locations. Only personnel trained and experienced in the equipment operation may operate this equipment.
- · This machine is not to be operated by anyone under the age of 18.
- Turn the kettle heat switch, kettle motor and light/warmer switch ON.
- Empty contents of "All In One Popcorn" into the kettle and close the lid.
- Once the popcorn has stopped popping (no more than 5 min) rotate the knob dump handle to empty the kettle. Return the kettle back to the upright position.
- Repeat this cycle for each additional batch of popcorn.
- Turn off the kettle heat switch after the final batch to eliminate smoke and odor.
- Turn kettle motor and light/warmer switches OFF. Ensure all switches are OFF when there is no popcorn in the kettle
- After letting the kettle cool, wipe the exterior to prevent the remaining oil from burning
- When not popping keep the glass doors CLOSED and the drop panel OPEN.
- Clear intake and exhaust holes (top of the machine) from any obstruction.





TROUBLESHOOTING

	PROBLEM	QUICK FIX
	Kettle Does Not Heat	Make sure kettle lead-in cord is plugged in and twisted to lock into the kettle receptacle.
	Long Popping Cycles	Low voltage. Ensure unit is plug into appropriate source.
		Ensure that unit is connect directly into outlet source (no extension cord).



ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS

▲ DANGER

- Machine must be properly grounded to prevent electrical shock to personnel. Failure to do so could result in serious injury, or death.
- Do not immerse any part of this equipment in water.
- Do not use excessive water when cleaning.
- Keep cord and plug off the ground and away from moisture.
- Do not use an extension cord.
- Always unplug the equipment before cleaning or servicing.
- Make sure all machine switches are in the OFF position before plugging the equipment into the receptacle.

HOW TO PREPARE POPCORN

POP CORN French O' Hos	4oz Kettle	4 to 5 Theatre Bags / package
	6oz Kettle	4 to 5 Theatre Bags / Package 200 to 250 Bags / Case
Each Theatre Bag 4 Cups of Popcorn	8oz Kettle	6 to 7 Theatre Bags / Package 150 to 180 Bags / Case

BEFORE RETURNING

- A \$47.50 cleaning charge will apply to each steam table if units are not returned in the same condition they were received.
- To avoid cleaning charges, allow the kettle to cool for at least 1hour before attempting to clean. Unplug Kettle and remove it from the machine. With a cloth, wipe out the inside of the kettle ,kettle lid, crossbar, outside, and underneath of the kettle.
- Do not place the kettle in water. This will cause damage to electrical components and result in replacement charges.
